At check in you will also be asked if you have fever or cough or travel. If you have experienced fever or cough, please seek care with your family physician or local hospital.

Increased sanitization will take place in the clinic areas which are within Coronavirus guidelines.

Any patient is encouraged to use available hand sanitizers and soaps to wash hands.

Contact Lens wearers should consider wearing glasses more often to help avoiding touching the eyes. Corrective lenses or sun shades can shield your eyes from infected respiratory droplets. Avoid rubbing your eyes.
